Welcome back to you all after the summer break.

- **PE Kits.** Please could you make sure that your child has a complete PE in school. PE kits need to remain in school for the half term and will be sent home for washing when we break up for the October holiday.
- **School Shoes.** Please could all the children wear black school shoes, as per the school uniform policy. Training/sports shoes are not permitted for school. Many thanks for your cooperation.
- **Jewellery/Hair.** Please could we remind parents that only plain stud earrings and a watch are allowed to be worn for school. Earrings must be removed (by your child) for PE or swimming. If for any reason earrings cannot be removed for PE, plasters need to be provided from home as a cover up. Long hair needs to be tied back at all times and any bobbles, headbands need to be plain. Many thanks for your support.
- **Water Bottles.** Please could all the children (with the exception of the Reception children) have a water bottle in school, labelled with their name. The children are encouraged to drink regularly from the water machines in school.
